NHS

GP referral required
Initial appointment is with a member of the fertility team at the NHS Fertility Clinic on Level E, Princess Anne Hospital

Private

Patient can self refer
Initial appointment is with a fertility consultant at Complete Fertility Centre. This private appointment will be sooner than patients with an appointment for the NHS Fertility Clinic

Investigations required before initial appointment

FSH, LH, Progesterone, rubella, chlamydia, semen analysis & AMH. All can be undertaken by your GP except AMH which can be done privately at Complete Fertility Centre.

Initial Appointment (either NHS or Private)

Will discuss:

- Patient's fertility history
- Results of investigations and ultrasound scan
 - Pros and cons of treatment options
- Whether assisted conception is required and best treatment option

Counselling

We encourage patients to meet with our Counsellor for emotional support

Nurse talks through treatment schedule & how to administer drugs

Treatment starts

Drugs delivered directly to patients home. Treatment usually takes 4 weeks and starts on day 1 of period
