Before we can recommend a treatment pathway you will need to have a **consultation with a doctor** and may need a **combination of investigations**. This will allow us to advise you on the best treatment journey for you.

At **Complete Fertility Centre** we offer a range of simple fertility tests to assess your overall reproductive health and identify any potential fertility issues that might be affecting your chances of conceiving.

We have a **counselling service** here to help offer emotional support before, during and after your treatment, should you wish to access it.

Fertility Check-ups

Our fertility check-up aims to offer you a **comprehensive overview** of your fertility.

Here at Complete Fertility, we understand that you may be wondering about your fertility health. It may be that you're in a relationship and are thinking about trying to conceive in the future or you're actively trying now, or you may be single and have concerns about your fertility.

Whatever your circumstances it is worthwhile **monitoring your fertility levels** to support your family planning. Our fertility check-up can be performed individually or as a couple to evaluate your fertility.

HyCoSy

It is not possible to see the tubes with normal x-rays or ultrasound, so a specialised examination must be performed. You will have a transvaginal ultrasound first. This is a routine gynaecological procedure and does not hurt.

We aim to perform this procedure **between day 8 and 18 of your cycle**. Please note that we will not be able to do the examination if you are still bleeding from your period or if there is a chance that you may be pregnant. If you are unsure, please phone us.

If there is a failed HyCoSy attempt, then there will be a 25% refund.

- HyCoSy stands for Hysterosalpingo Contrast Sonography, & it is used for investigating the cavity of the uterus & the fallopian tubes to see if an egg can travel down them with ease (this may be required if the cavity or tubes are damaged, & it is difficult to become pregnant). £550

Trans-Vaginal Ultrasound Assessment Scan

- This is an assessment scan which is required to examine & take images of the pelvic anatomy. It helps to see if there is any abnormality in the uterus (womb), cervix (the neck of the womb), endometrium (lining of the womb), fallopian tubes, ovaries, bladder, or the pelvic cavity. £195

Hysteroscopy

- A hysteroscopy is sometimes required, & it is a procedure to look at the inside of your uterus (womb) using a small telescope. Often a biopsy (removing small pieces of tissue from the lining of your womb) is performed at the same time. £1,100
- If there is a failed hysteroscopy attempt, then there will be a £100 refund. Histology costs in addition.

Endometrial Biopsy

- A biopsy of the endometrium without assessing the endometrium visually may be required. This is similar to a smear test in terms of being examined & then a small tube is passed through the neck of the womb to take the biopsy. £220
- Occasionally, your doctor may advise a sampling of other tissue/fluid e.g., polyp, fluid from ovarian cysts for diagnostic purposes. The prices will vary for these procedures. £80-£400



Semen Analysis

- A semen analysis may be required, which is an examination by microscope of the number of sperm in a semen sample (sperm count or concentration), how they swim (motility) & their shape (morphology). We also assess the sperm to see if there are antibodies present that could cause the sperm to stick together. £180
- Following your semen analysis, a report will be written & sent to either you or your referring doctor and kept on file at Complete. A semen analysis gives your doctor important information about your fertility, & if you're seeking treatment, will also help the doctor decide which type of treatment is right for you.


Sperm Comet / Sperm DNA Fragmentation

A SpermComet/Sperm DNA fragmentation test may be recommended. This is a specialist test performed to **check sperm quality and sperm DNA damage**. Good quality sperm DNA is vital for normal fertilisation, embryo development, and successful implantation and pregnancy in both natural and assisted reproduction. Some early studies have suggested that poor sperm DNA may be associated with recurrent miscarriage and lower success rates for some patients that have had repeated attempts at IVF.

This test is only recommended by a doctor in specific circumstances, and you will be given information about the test and its relevance for you at the time of referral. It can take up to a month for test results to be fully processed. When you book your test, we will also usually arrange a follow up appointment for you and your partner to discuss the results with your doctor.

Follicular Tracking

	Tracking ovulation may be recommended & is the best way to identify the appropriate time to get pregnant. It involves monitoring your cycle by ultrasound.	£195
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Accurately predicting ovulation can be a little trickier than figuring out when day 14 is for you. Ovulation can be irregular, or it can be affected by diet, stress, illness, or medical conditions such as polycystic ovary syndrome.

Ovulation is triggered by a surge of luteinising hormone (LH) from the pituitary gland. LH also stimulates the ovary to begin producing the hormone progesterone. This surge normally occurs 24-48 hours before ovulation & can be tracked more accurately with blood tests and ultrasounds.

Treatment Planning Consultation

Nurse Consultation

The next appointment which is required is with one of our nurses who will talk through your treatment schedule as advised by your consultant in more detail, run through your consents and go through how to administer any medication required. This involves completing legal documentation in relation for your upcoming treatment. In addition, the treatment protocol and drugs information will be discussed in detail. By the end of this appointment, you should feel more confident in understanding the fertility process you are about to embark upon.

IVF Packages

In vitro fertilisation (IVF), which literally means "fertilisation in glass", refers to assisted reproduction that takes place outside of the body.

During the IVF process, eggs are removed from the ovaries and fertilised with sperm in the laboratory. The fertilised egg (embryo) is later placed in the womb. If the treatment is successful, an embryo will implant in the lining of the womb. The patient will then be pregnant, as if they had conceived naturally.

IVF can be performed with the single egg that is produced naturally each month, but this is inefficient and has low success rates. Therefore, in the majority of treatment cycles, the patient undergoes stimulation of the ovaries with fertility hormones so that several eggs are obtained. This process is called superovulation.

The production of several embryos means that the best quality embryos can be placed, thus improving success rates. It can also result in the production of "spare" embryos. Good quality spare embryos may be frozen to allow placement at a later date without the need for hormone stimulation. This maximises the chance of pregnancy from one egg collection.

Frozen Embryo Transfer (FET) Package

A frozen embryo transfer is when frozen embryos from a previous IVF or ICSI cycle are thawed and placed in the womb.

Typically, 50% of IVF and ICSI patients will have other good quality embryos to freeze, after having had their best one or two transferred, although the chances of having any embryos to freeze varies significantly on age and other medical factors, which your consultant can discuss with you. If couples wish, the healthy embryos not transferred may be frozen for later cycles. This allows you to attempt pregnancy again without going through the complete IVF process, avoiding stimulated egg growth and the accompanying injections.

Intrauterine Insemination (IUI) Package

Intrauterine Insemination (IUI) is a fertility treatment whereby the patient is helped to conceive by specially prepared sperm being placed directly into the womb at the time when eggs are being released. Production of eggs is helped by the use of fertility drugs. When you are about to ovulate, the most motile sperm will be used for insemination.

If you are using sperm from a donor this is known as donor insemination (DI). It is carried out when sperm are completely absent, the partner has a very low sperm count or if they carry a genetic disorder.

For patients having IUI with donor sperm, we have our own in-house sperm bank. All our sperm donors are background checked with extensive screening and full medical examinations. Donors can be selected based on their physical characteristics, their employment, education, and hobbies. You also have the option to import sperm from another agreed centre, if we do not have a donor in our own bank who matches your desired characteristics (this may incur transportation charges, see below transport and storage section). Alternatively, you can use a known sperm donor.

All patients having treatment using donor sperm are required to use our counselling service, to fully explore the implications of donor insemination, before making any final decisions.

Egg Freezing Package

Egg freezing offers the option to start a family when you are ready without worrying about your biological clock.

You might choose egg freezing if you are:

- considering postponing childbearing for social reasons
- considering cancer treatment or other treatment that may cause you to lose your fertility
- at increased risk of premature ovarian failure or early menopause
- wishing to undergo a sex change

Age is a major factor when considering egg freezing. Fertility is at its peak for individuals in their twenties. You have the most eggs and the highest quality eggs when you are young. Ideally, you should have this procedure in your twenties or early thirties, but you can consider it later on. You should discuss this with your consultant who can give individual guidance.

The egg freezing process includes:

1. Pre-treatment screening tests – to determine if egg freezing is a good option for you
2. Egg production stimulation – our team of experts will monitor and enhance your ovulation to increase egg production
3. Egg collection – a 30-minute procedure under ultrasound guidance
4. Egg freezing – using a process called vitrification your eggs are rapidly frozen to -196 °C in liquid nitrogen
5. Egg storage – your frozen eggs are stored in one of our secure tanks containing liquid nitrogen until you choose to use them to become pregnant

Egg Thawing Package

The egg thawing package is for patients who wish to use their frozen eggs to generate embryos and then have an embryo transfer. Because of the way that eggs are frozen, they must then be inseminated by ICSI, which is included in the package price.

Your menstrual cycle will be controlled with medication and your eggs thawed at the appropriate time in your cycle. They will then be inseminated with ICSI. Any embryos that develop will be grown in the laboratory for up to five days, the best one or two transferred, and any other good quality embryos can be frozen.

Egg Sharing

IVF Egg Sharing with an Anonymous Recipient S1

Egg sharing involves donating half of the eggs collected during your IVF cycle to an anonymous recipient who is unable to produce good quality eggs of their own. This gives both you and the egg recipient the chance of having a baby.

Our S1 package includes everything you will need for a standard IVF cycle.

This package may be of interest if you would like to help other patient to have a child through the gift of egg sharing, and if you are not eligible for NHS funded Treatment or you have had an unsuccessful NHS funded cycle. *Eligibility criteria apply.*

A minimum of 8 eggs is required for the donation to take place. If less than 8 eggs are retrieved, the sharer keeps all of the eggs, and the donation is cancelled (at no extra cost).

IVF Egg Freezing and Share S3

Egg freezing offers the opportunity to prepare for a future family whilst your fertility is most likely to be at its optimum. Freezing eggs allows you to plan a family when the time is right for you, and it also removes potential concerns about your biological clock.

Age is a major factor when considering egg freezing. Fertility is typically at its peak for individuals in their twenties, as we are likely to have the most and the highest quality eggs when we are younger. Ideally, the optimum time to have this procedure is in your twenties or early thirties, but you should always discuss this with your consultant who can give individual guidance.

Egg freezing and share involves donating half the eggs collected during your egg freeze cycle. The donated eggs will be allocated to an anonymous recipient(s) who cannot produce good quality eggs of their own. *Eligibility criteria apply.*

Our S3 package includes everything you will need for one standard egg freeze cycle.

A minimum of 12 eggs are required for the donation to take place. If less than 12 eggs are retrieved, you will be given the option to keep all the eggs for your future treatment (*additional freezing and storage fees would apply).

Transport & Storage

Freezing & Storage

Patients may wish to freeze and store sperm for a multitude of different reasons: low sperm count ahead of IVF treatment (“back up freeze”), surgical sperm retrieval, medical treatment (for example for cancer) that may put their fertility at risk, vasectomy, gender transition, or military deployment, for example.

Anyone freezing sperm will also be required to be screened for HIV, Hepatitis B and Hepatitis C, and potentially other illnesses depending on their medical and travel history.

Medication costs vary depending on your individual needs but please find an approximate cost range below. For IVF cycles we order enough medication to cover an average of 12 days of stimulation. If any further drugs are required, these will be discussed during your treatment. Please note that medication is non-refundable, including any unused drugs, but some surplus medication may be used in a subsequent cycle at a later date, if clinically appropriate.

A dispensing fee will be payable for each prescription, with all new cycles incurring a standard dispensing fee in the first instance.
